TREASURER REPORT: TSgt Pinkley was not in attendance. SrA Gregg reported that we have \$867.39 in checking and \$2151.76 in savings. Total being \$3019.15. AFSA audit will be completed by SSgt Shawn Williams on 12 February 2016.

LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS: CMSgt (Ret) Ott:

- Service members face a critical decision during the next year regarding whether to opt into the new military retirement system or stick with the original one. The new retirement benefit will mean smaller pension checks but include cash contributions to the individual investment accounts of all troops. The new system takes place Jan. 1, 2018. After that, troops coming out of boot camp will be automatically enrolled in the new benefit as the traditional pension plan is phased out. For today's troops, and anyone who joins during the next two years, the new law includes a grandfather clause that will allow them to choose to remain under the traditional all-or-nothing retirement system.

MEMBERSHIP& RETENTION: Mr. Bamburg

- Mr. Bamburg reiterated the importance of recruiting new members. We currently have approximately 566 active members and 22 lapsed members since January. We've retained 23 members. Our lapsed members have risen because the individuals that have lapsed are now staying on the roster for a year instead of two months. This is to allow us additional opportunity to contact them prior to them falling off. He discussed the importance of recruiting new members and staying active in AFSA to retain our benefits such as GI Bill changes and TA! We gained 103 new members in 2015 allowing us to receive a free registration to the PAC in 2016. AFSA's overall membership is nearing 100,000, if we drop below 100,000 AFSA will lose its clout on Capitol Hill. Effective 1 January, AFSA put out an awesome deal for first time members; \$25 for a five year emembership! The only downside to getting the e-membership is that you won't get a hardcopy AFSA magazine.
